

NOTICE OF RACE

Junior Sailing Regatta 2019

1. RULES

- a. The series will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the 2013-2016 ISAF (RRS), *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- b. Racing will be governed by the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA), the RYA Portsmouth Yardstick
- c. Scheme 2019, this Notice of Race, and any amendments thereto and the respective Class Rules. Class rules apply even when not racing as a class.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The series is open to all Juniors who are 18 and under on the 1st of January 2019. This applies to both crew and helm in the case of double handed boats
- b. In the case of double handed boats
- c. All participants are required to be members of Galway City Sailing Club or an Irish Sailing affiliated club.

3. Fees

- a. The fees are 10 euros for a single handed boat and 15 euros for a double handed boat when booked on-line or 15 euros for a single handed boat and 20 euros for a double handed boat on if registering on the morning of the regatta. There may be an opportunity to hire a boat for non-members

4. SCHEDULE

- a. Registration will be from 9am to 10am on the 7th of September. Briefing will be at 10:15am and first gun at 11:00am

5. Class Flags

- a. Class flags will be:
 - i. Topper class T

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Sailing instructions will be posted closer to the date

7. Scoring

- a. It is hoped to run 4 races. In the event that 4 races are run there will be a discard. 3 races will constitute a series

8. PRIZES

- a. Prizes will be given for each of the categories at the end of the regatta. Categories will be decided closer to the date
