#### Social Distancing & Etiquette -Please maintain a 2 metre space between you and others at all times.

- Try to anticipate the movements of others in this regard.
- Do not shake hands or make close contact with others.
- Wash or sanitize your hands prior to and after touching 'public' property.
- You are advised to bring your own sanitiser for added personal protection.
- Do not touch other people's property.
- Avoid touching your face and or mouth.
- Cough in your elbow.
- Wash your hands regularly.

# Access to your boat

- Please make your way to your boat adhering to Social Distancing guidelines at all times.
- Water will be available to clean and wash down boats, however no hoses will be available. We recommend members bring their own hose or bucket & sponge as needed.
- Please be mindful of not to Use/Waste excessive water.
- Please remember to remove all waste including oil/Paint Tins etc. There are no waste facilities onsite.
- All boats currently accommodated in the hard are situated in close physical proximity to one another. <u>Please respect the 2M distance rule as advised by Gov Guidelines.</u>

- Lifting/Launching of boats will be accommodated where possible subject to weather and Tides and operator being available. Please ensure you have adequate crew available when Launching/Lifting as delays will incur additional cost.
